

About the Programme

The programme for Cross-border Cooperation between the Republic of Serbia and Bosnia and Herzegovina (BiH) is implemented under the framework of the Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance (IPA II). IPA II supports Cross-border Cooperation with a view to promoting good neighborly relations, fostering Union integration and promoting socio-economic development.

Financed projects reinforce economic cooperation, as well as activities related to environmental protection, tourism, culture, agriculture, education, research and development, employment, institutional cooperation, etc. Funds are being donated with an obligation of the beneficiary to co-finance its project in the amount of minimum 15% of the project value. Potential beneficiaries apply for funds through calls for project proposals.

The overall Union co-financing to the Cross-border Cooperation programme for the period 2014-2020 is 14,000,000 EUR while Beneficiaries co-financing is expected to be 2,223,529.41 EUR
